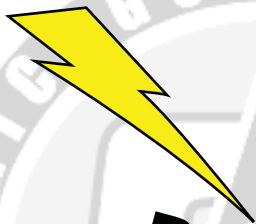

The Chicago Storm, a member of the Major Indoor Soccer League (MISL) introduces "STORMING SCHOOLS" educational program. It's simple, direct, and a ton of fun!

It includes four parts!

Part One: "Storming Schools" Curriculum Provided by Daily Herald Newspaper in Education for Each Student

This curriculum integrates topics such as reading, math, history and geography with the game of soccer. "Storming Schools" curriculum shows students a different perspective on the importance of education.



Part Two: Chicago Storm Operation School Assembly (OSA)

Opportunity for students and staff to meet and interact with Storm players during a 45 minute interactive and educational school assembly, promoting important life lessons used on and off the soccer field. The players speak passionately about why to stay in school and stay away from drugs and alcohol. Students will gain confidence to achieve daily tasks and know the importance of hard work and smart decision making.

Part Three: School Day Game Field Trip

Students are rewarded for their hard work by attending a Chicago Storm School Day

Game. This field trip, \$9 per student or \$13 per student with lunch, takes place in February 2007 at the Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates. Students watch the very same players they met and studied play against a rival MISL team. In addition to the game, students will view an educational halftime show and take advantage of the concourse which will be set-up to host various kid-friendly booths offering students an activity-filled day.

Part Four: Daily Herald Classroom Copies

Classrooms will be provided with 25 copies of the Daily Herald on the weekday of their choice throughout the school year, to encourage students to read articles reinforcing the Chicago Storm message.

The Chicago Storm is a member of the Major Indoor Soccer League (MISL). The MISL features top level soccer players from 29 different countries. Known for great individual skill and speed of play, the Chicago Storm will leave you amazed and entertained!
